

## **CHAPLAIN'S SON BELIEVED KILLED**

Senior Chaplain and Mrs Alex Stewart, of 17 Buckland av, Newtown, Geelong, have been advised that their elder son, Lieutenant A. Ian Stewart, previously reported missing, has now been posted as "missing, believed killed, on or after March 7, 1942." This news was received by the military authorities from prisoners of war rescued after the sinking of a Japanese transport. Lieutenant Stewart joined the AIF in 1940 when he was 20, and served in the Middle East and Syria, where he gained his commission. He then landed in Java in February, 1942, with his battalion, the 2/2nd Pioneers.
